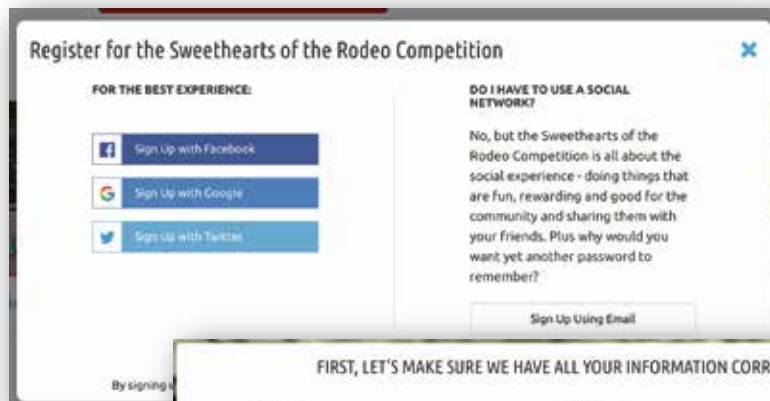


How to Join SweetHearts of the Rodeo

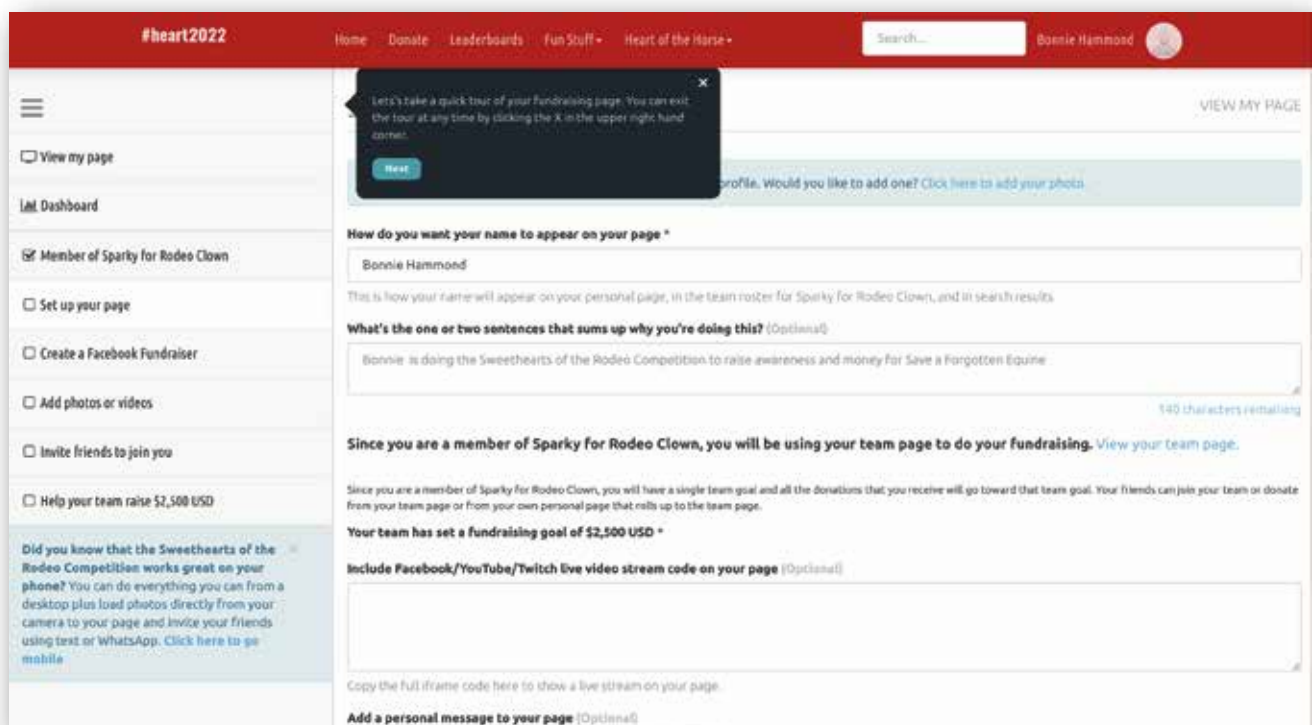
Step 1: Go to <https://p2p.onecause.com/sweethearts>

Step 3: Follow prompts to register yourself for the competition

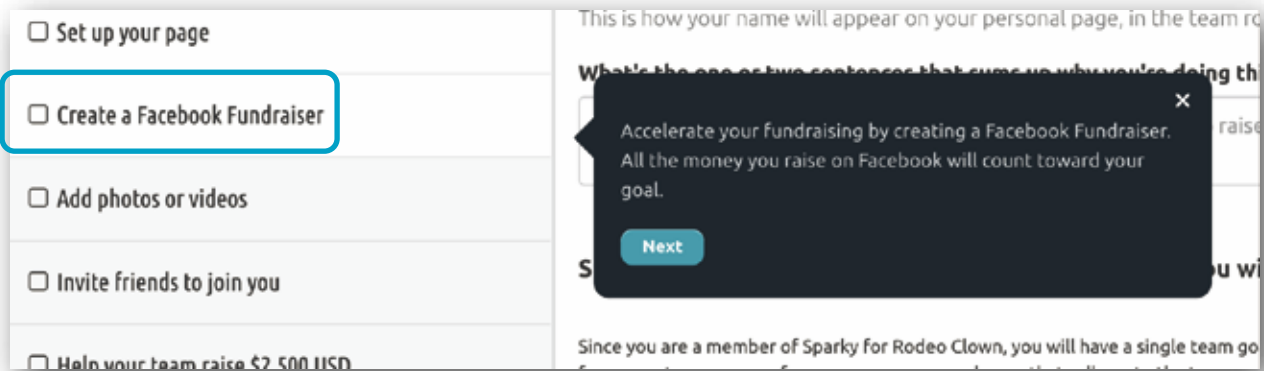


Step 4: Follow the pop-ups for a quick tour of your page.

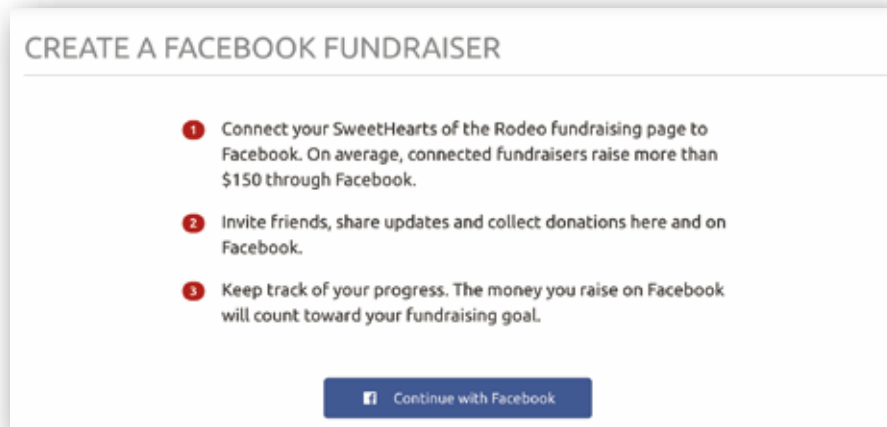

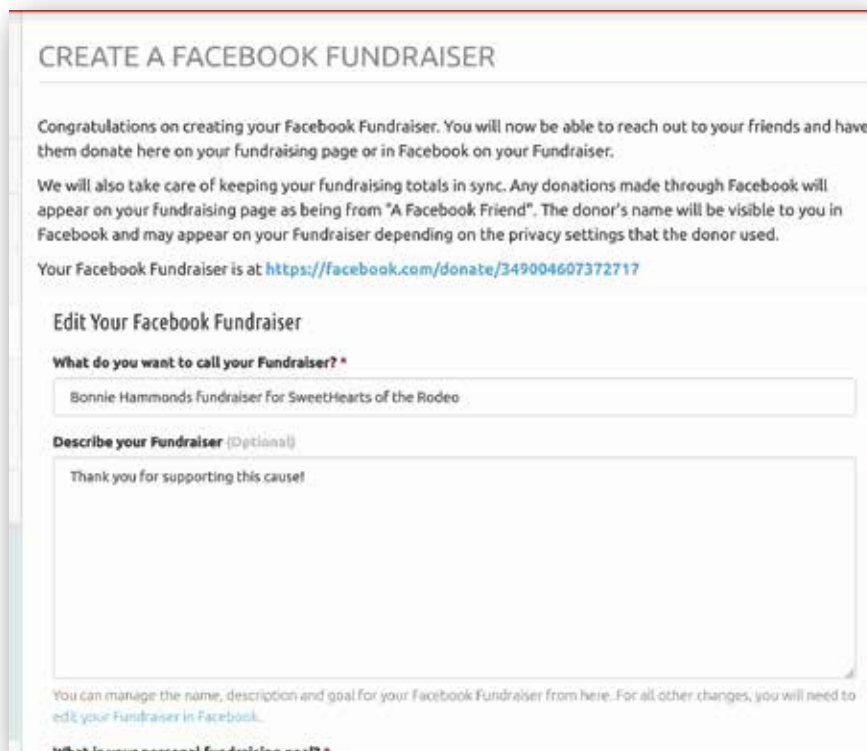
Step 1: Click Create a Facebook Fundraiser



Step 2: Create a post and click Post to Facebook



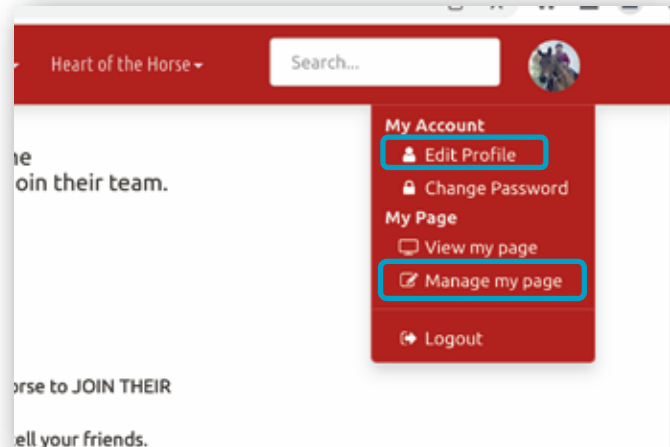

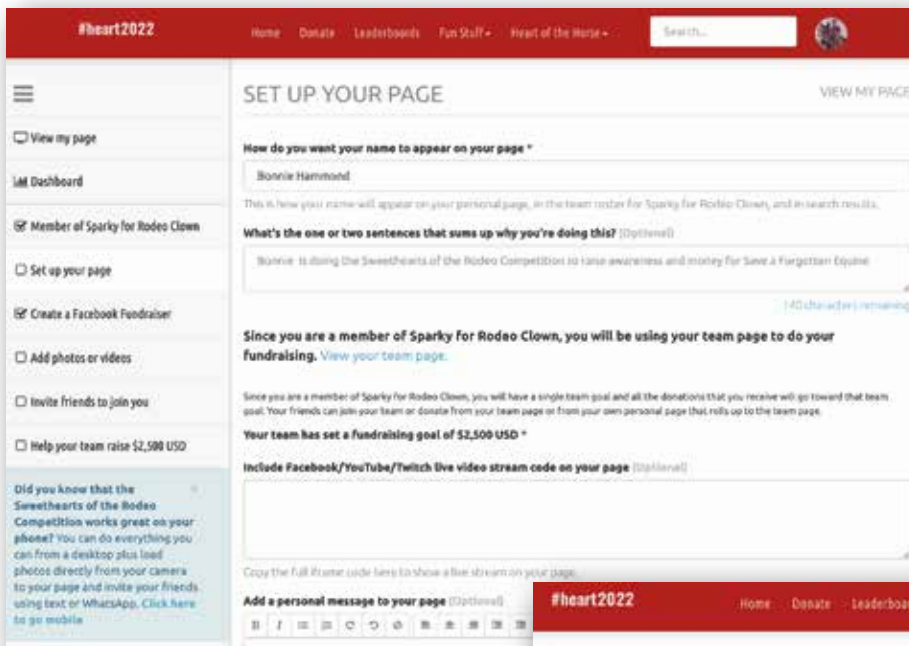
