How to Properly Enjoy Yourself at Heart of the Horse

First and foremost, let your hair down and let's have some fun! Put your cell phone away because you won't need that until the night is over. We're running this auction the old fashioned way this year!

Silent Auction

As you walk in through the gate of the covered arena, you'll notice a fairly impressive Silent Auction taking place just off to your left. Wander through and take a look at the fine items up for bid. If you see something that you think you might fancy, all you need to do is write your Bid Number on the item's Bid Sheet, next to the amount you'd care to wager. If someone else comes along and places a higher bid than yours...well, you'll have to come back and place an even higher bid. When the auction closes at 6:25pm, the person who has placed the highest bid is the winner of that item. Simple, right?

If you really don't want to risk losing the thing you want, all you have to do write your Bidder Number in the box marked **BUY IT NOW**. You'll pay top dollar, but no one can take it from you after that. Remind yourself **it's for the horses**.

Grand Silent Auction

That cowbell you've been hearing, why that's the Grand Silent Auction in action! Wander over and place a bid with the pretty lady in front of the chalkboard. She's going to write your bid next to the item you bid on, then she's going to ring that cowbell so everyone in the room knows that you've got the winning bid. Conversely, if you wander off to get a beer and you hear the cowbell, you'd better get back on over to the Grand Silent because chances are, you've been outbid! **Remember, fortune favors the persistent!** Don't let some other guest outbid you! This insanity continues until the Grand Silent Auction ends at 6:30pm.



Our Emcee: Patti Payne




